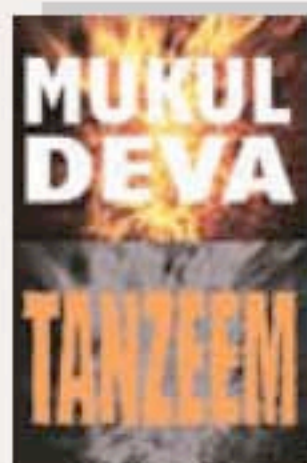

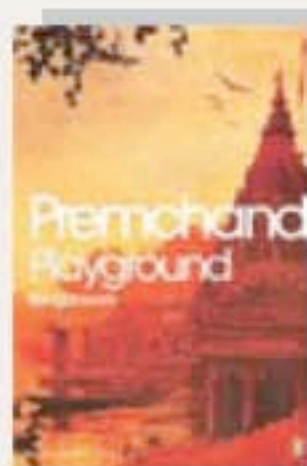


## STORY OF TERRORISM
