I was busy looking a unusual titles to read and came across an author "Mukul Deva" who has written a lot of fiction related to army insurgency operations across the border type of stories. Tanzeem is the story of Iqbal who is part of an elite Force-22 that the Indian Government has set up to destroy its enemies - namely the unknown terrorist and jihadis from across the border. The story starts with Iqbal looking at his wife's dead body. His wife has been tortured and killed by some sadist jihadi group from across the border. There is an important plan from that same jihadi group to do something BIG. Colonel Anbu is the main commander of the Elite-22 force and he is like a father figure to Iqbal. Iqbal wants revenge of his wife's death from the Ameer (the leader of the jihadist group). He is sent in across the border to do his task and get information about the main BIG thing and plus he also has revenge on his mind.
